BENEFIT COST ANALYSIS

FAA has concurred with our estimation that the 900ft extension of Rwy 4/22 will cost less than \$10 million, therefore NO further Benefit Cost Analysis (BCA) will be required on that project. A separate BCA will be needed on the proposed approach lighting system (MALSF) to be eligible for federal funding. We are working with AECOM & FAA to collect the required data.
